

**As from April 25<sup>th</sup> 2006, British Airways is introducing self-service check-in for customers travelling on UK domestic flights. From this date, the options for customers to check-in will be as follows.**

### **Check-in Options**

#### **Option 1 – Online check-in**

- choose your seat early
- print your boarding pass, and avoid airport check-in (where available)
- collect your boarding pass at a Self-Service Check-in kiosk or check-in desk
- drop any hold baggage at the airport 'Fast Bag Drop' desk (where available)

Online Check-in is available from 24 hours before departure.

#### **Option 2 – Self-Service Check-in kiosks at the airport**

- choose your own seat
- print your boarding pass
- drop any hold baggage at the airport 'Fast Bag Drop' desk (where available)

If the booking was made with a travel agent, insert your Frequent Flyer card or credit/debit card to identify yourself. You will then be asked for further information about your flight contained in your confirmation and e-ticket instructions, in order to continue with check-in.

Your card is used for identification purposes only and will not be charged.
